












Our Approach

Staff and parents at this centre sought to improve the play experience for the children and invited us to prepare concept plans and tender drawings.

The play area is small and intensely used, and we identified a number of opportunities to improve the way the playground contributed to development of movement skills (vestibular, proprioceptive, coordination), sensory awareness, and mental and creative stimulation along with safety.

The Concept Plan seeks to retain valued existing play elements, and 'value-add' new features, such as small spaces for refuge and imaginative play, natural loose materials, and planting.

A focus is to renovate the sandpit with rounded rendered walls and add water play, with a hand water pump and 'waterplay path'.

Stage 1 of the project was constructed in 2014 and further works are planned.
