

Our Approach

As an organisation with physical campuses at Burwood, Waurn Ponds, Geelong Waterfront and Warrnambool, the challenge for Deakin University is to maintain consistent landscape treatments while reflecting the individual character of each campus.

PM&A Landscape Architects was appointed to prepare a masterplan of external treatments to help maintain uniformity of treatments and procedures across all campuses while recognising and celebrating the character of each site.

The Campus Environmental Design Standards identifies the particular history, landscape characteristics and design direction of each campus, and provides clear guidance to facility managers and external consultants in the design and construction of outdoor spaces.

It defines the style and materials palette to be used across all campuses, and where the 'rules' should be relaxed to allow use of bespoke custom elements.

The Standards have become a key tool to minimise maintenance costs, streamline the approvals process and to manage the landscape values of the four sites.
