Our Approach

The vision for the landscaping around the new Shire offices in Bannockburn is to demonstrate fire-wise landscape techniques and the flora of the Western Plains as well as supporting council's policies on health, wellbeing and the environment,

The entry landscaping features raised, irregularly shaped beds of rusty coreten steel with low native and indigenous groundcovers and vertical salvaged tree trunks, marked and scarred black by fire, as an interpretive reminder of historic fire events.

The outdoor staff area provides space for work and relaxation, with tables, soft grass, shady deciduous trees, BBQ, bike parking and Wifi/data connectivity.

A 50KL underground concrete water tank stores harvested stormwater for irrigation and creates a grassy mound that frames the staff area with rock gabion retaining walls

The project included concept design, documentation and inspections during the construction phase, with completion expected in late 2019.
